

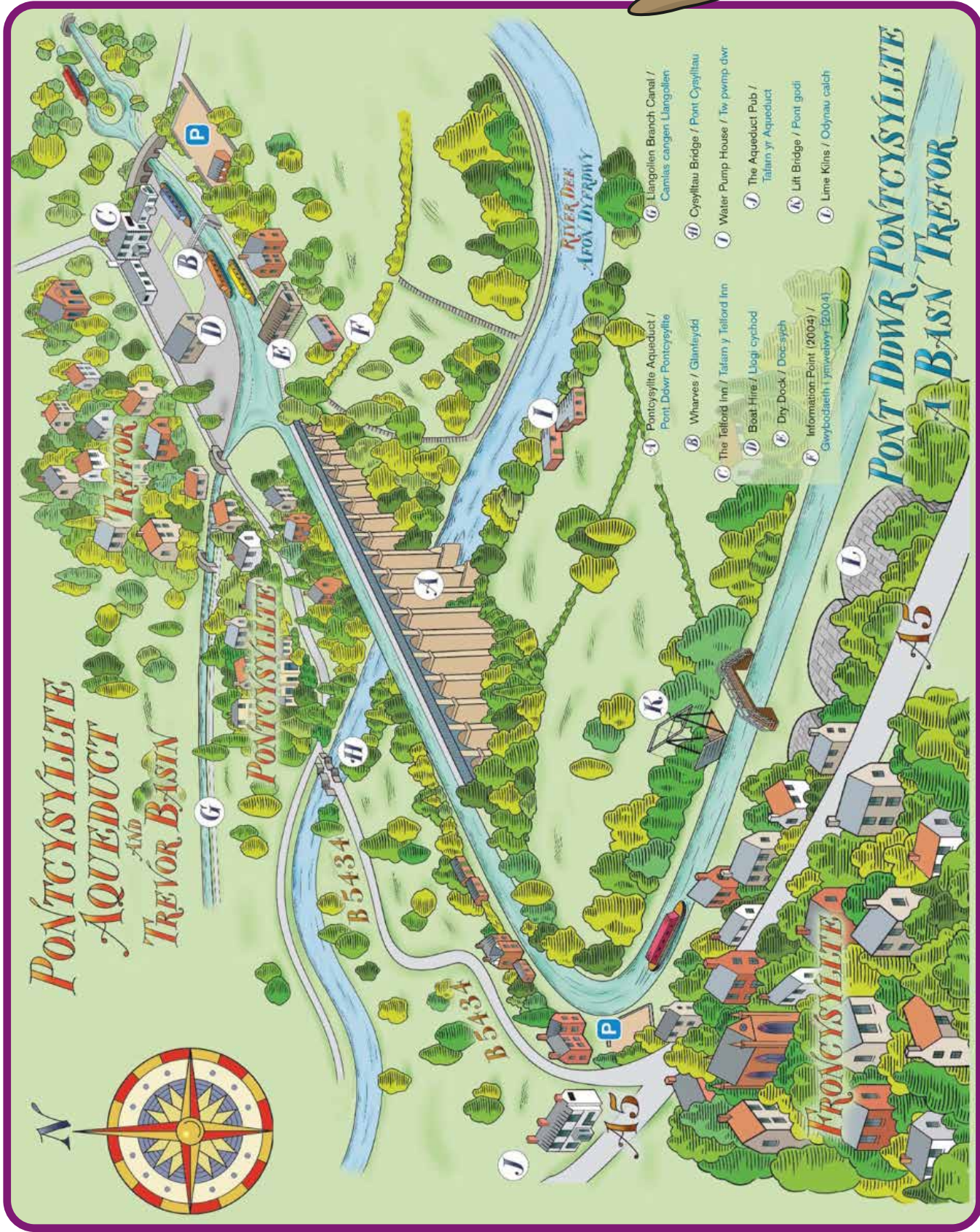

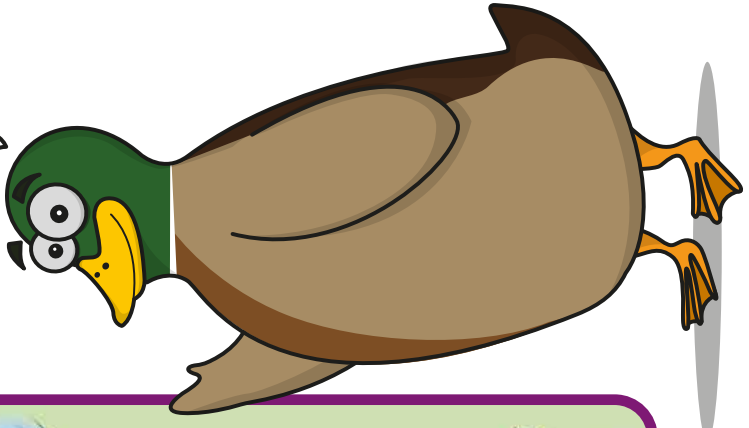

Look

Look carefully at the boat building tools.

together? Hope they replaced it!

Do you recognise any of the types of tool?

Touch

Feel the oakum, which is bits of rope.
Try and find out what it was used for.



Touch

Now why not try being an engineer and
build the aqueduct model. Hopefully it will
take you less than the 10 years it took to
build the real thing!



Sniff

Find the two tar burners behind
the visitor centre. Can you smell
the tar they used to boil here?
Pooh smelly!



What do you think they might have used the tar for?



Look

Outside the visitor centre is an unusual bench.
Look at the words written on the posts. Which phrase
is the only real one? Can you find on the post?

What other words can you see?

Look

Find the hand sculpture.

What objects can you recognise?

Can you find any clues about the past here?



Touch

Feel the railings by the edge of the aqueduct.

Can you feel the grooves where the horses pulling the boats dragged their ropes?

Imagine the strength they would have needed to wear the metal.



Listen

Follow the path down towards to the river next to the hand sculpture, so you can investigate the aqueduct from below.

What sounds can you hear from here?

Look

Wow it's quite a sight from down here!

Look carefully at the pillars holding up the iron trough that carries the canal.

What do you think they're made of?

How tall do you think they are?

Look

Find the stone sculptures next to the car park.

Try and find the carved clue that answers this question.

What was the mortar for the aqueduct made from?
